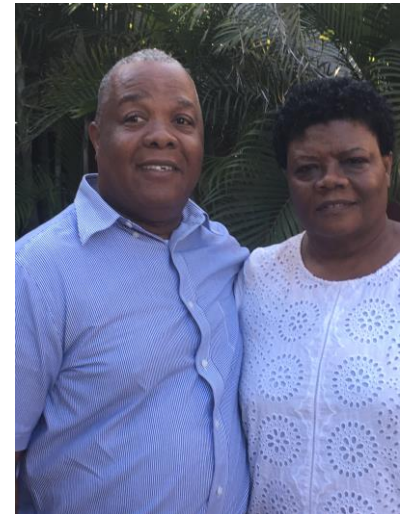

Here in Boston, it is windy and very cold, but the atmosphere is very festive: colorful lights, houses are nicely decorated, nativity scenes are almost everywhere, and we even see a choir in their nice accoutrements singing Christmas carols in a mall.

As we reflect on all of these things, we realize that during this season so many people are focused on so many details that they miss the real meaning of the season. Christmas is about Him.

Today I can still hear an echo of the heavenly messenger, *"And there in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over the flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be for all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."* (Luke 2: 8-11 KJV)

Lying in the manger was a baby. He is divinity wrapped in swaddling clothes. He is God veiled in the flesh. There is reason to rejoice and to celebrate. And consequently the heavenly host erupted in praises and adoration saying; *"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men."* (Luke 2: 14 KJV)
